Dr. Khan founded a number of prestigious institutions over the last two decades, including Ghulam Ishaq Khan Institute Topi; Sir Syed CASE Institute of Technology Islamabad; Dr. A. Q. Khan Institute of Biotechnology and Genetic Engineering Karachi; Dr. A. Q. Khan Institute of Technology Mianwali; Dr. A. Q. Khan Institute of Technology Kahuta; Institute of Behavioural Sciences Karachi; Senior Citizen's Foundation Islamabad; SACHET-Pakistan and Dr. A. Q. Khan Hospital Trust, Lahore to quote a few. These academic, engineering sciences and health institutions have elevated the level of education in the fields of science, technology and public health and have changed the lives of millions of Pakistanis. He was also Patron of a number of other non-government organizations engaged in socio economic development of Pakistani society. He wrote articles in newspapers until the very end, disseminating awareness for the general public on social, moral, spiritual and economic issues.

SACHET (Society for the Advancement of Community, Health, Education and Training) was founded in 1999 by Dr. A. Q. Khan, NI & Bar, HI. He led the organization as a life time President. SACHET is a community development organization working at grass root level with national outreach. The organization's name reveals its four key program areas i.e., health, education, livelihood, and training.

SACHET is recognized as a leading community development organization in Pakistan and has served millions of under privileged communities in all four provinces including Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Jammu Kashmir through several community driven projects.

During 23 years of its existence, SACHET has served more than 1.3 million patients, trained around 16,000 girls/women in vocational skills and employed; more than one million were reached through result-oriented advocacy on community issues through awareness programs. More than 20,000 youth and adolescents (boys and girls) were provided life skills training. SACHET pioneered gender specific youth and adolescent friendly centres in rural areas of Punjab and Islamabad capital Territory. More than 50,000 clients received family planning services through SACHET's Community Health Centres known as SACHET Clinics.

SACHET remains firmly committed to disseminate primary health care, awareness and services, to avert subsequent financial costs of secondary and tertiary health care and will continue working on that basis.

The subsequent pages give details of program targets achieved by the Society in various thematic areas for the period under review (from July 2020 to June 2021). It is commendable that despite the destruction and dislocation caused by the Covid-19 pandemic in Pakistan since January 2020, the Society has successfully strived to dispense much needed medical

services to the communities, wherever possible. Though some of its training programs, like skills development, language training, awareness raising, medical camps and even primary healthcare services were disrupted due to restriction imposed by the local authorities on public gathering.

However, the Society soon resumed its usual operations, with necessary precautions, which indicate the inherent resilience of the organization. The Society has not been able to continue its skills development program due to lack of funding from Punjab Skills Development Fund and is currently exploring ways and means of requesting the well-to-do in the communities to come forward and contribute in sustaining these programs.

I complement the local administration, donor institutions and management of the Society for their dedication, help and cooperation during the adversities faced in 2020-2021.

INTRODUCTION

SACHET-Pakistan (Society for the Advancement of Community, Health, Education and Training-Pakistan) is a multi-dimensional, forward looking, gender sensitive and environmentally friendly, welfare cum community development organization. A not-for-profit organization, working at grass root level in the community with national outreach, SACHET-Pakistan is making its contribution towards socio-economic progress since 1999. The organization's name reveals its four key program areas i.e., health, education, livelihood, and training. SACHET's programs are both needs and rights-based; with provision of free primary health care, education with an emphasis on female education; training for skills development and poverty alleviation cum income generation. Removal of discrimination in society on the basis of gender, class, ethnicity, religion or cultural diversity is at the heart of our programs.

SACHET has vast and substantive experience in advocacy and service delivery of primary health care, reproductive health and rights, education with a clear focus on gender mainstreaming and gender equality, as well as consciousness on practical and strategic gender needs. SACHET also deals with sensitive issues of violence against women, girls and children, within the broader domain of reproductive health programming. SACHET has vast experience of working with communities where rigorous community mobilization remained cross cutting area in its programs.

SACHET has proven experience in conducting consultations, workshops, seminars, youth summits, and women assemblies on district, provincial, national and international level. SACHET has conducted a series of policy dialogues in which it involved stakeholders from diverse groups for their opinions for producing the policy recommendation through consultative process. Over the period of last 23 years SACHET has worked with multiple range of stakeholders, irrespective of their religion and ethnicity, in all the provinces of Pakistan and owns a noteworthy goodwill among its wider network across the country.

THEMATIC AREAS OF SERVICE

1. Free Service Delivery of primary health services and care to the poor and indigent people on sustainable basis, in particular to mothers and children, to avert subsequent secondary and tertiary healthcare costs.
2. Reproductive Health services and dissemination of awareness for the protection of rights of the stakeholders in this field.
3. Awareness on violence against women, girls and children, within the broader domain of reproductive health programming.
4. Skills development with focus on income generating programs for both male and female members of the community.
5. Education (formal and non-formal) through strengthening public sector educational institutions.

GEOGRAPHICAL COVERAGE

Since its inception, SACHET is recognized as a leading community development organization in Pakistan and has served communities in all four provinces, including Gilgit Baltistan and Azad Jammu Kashmir, through several innovative and community driven projects. The permanent areas of intervention of SACHET's programs include districts of Islamabad, Rawalpindi and Attock through its Community Development Centres located at Banigala, Gagri, Pinyali and Pathargarh.

HEALTH PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS 2020-21



RAH (Responsible Actions for Health) is SACHET's largest delivery programme, and about 70% resources are allocated to activities in this area. RAH (راہ) is an Urdu word for way or a path leading to destination. This programme serves communities in two ways: A; by showing (sensitizing) them about healthy life styles and life choices through preventive health

education, and B; by obviating financial, cultural and geographical hurdles in the way of community in accessing health services.

During the financial year 2020-21, the three (3) SACHET Clinics Banigala, Gagri, and Pinyali remained open 242 days and fourth SACHET Clinic Pathargarh was operational for 148 days.

SALIENT FEATURES OF SACHET'S PRIMARY HEALTH CARE PROGRAM

Primary health care (PHC) is the first point of contact for individuals seeking medical attention. SACHET's Primary health care services provide accessible, affordable, and preventive care, offer continuity and coordination of care, and are community-oriented. By providing these essential services, primary health care helps to improve health outcomes and reduce healthcare costs.



ACCESSIBLE AND AFFORDABLE

SACHET Clinics are located in communities and are designed to be easily accessible to people. These services are usually more affordable than hospital care, making them the first choice for individuals seeking medical attention.



PREVENTIVE CARE

SACHET's health care services focus on preventing illnesses and promoting healthy behaviors. Clinics offer routine check-ups, immunizations, health education, and disease screening, which can help identify potential health problems early and prevent the development of more severe illnesses.



CONTINUITY OF CARE

SACHET Clinics offer continuity of care, meaning that individuals receive ongoing care from the same doctor or team of health service providers. This helps build a relationship between the doctor and the patient, leading to better health outcomes.



COORDINATION OF CARE

SACHET Clinics coordinate care between different providers and healthcare settings, such as hospitals and specialists. This helps ensure that individuals receive the right care at the right time, and that their health needs are met.



COMMUNITY-ORIENTED

SACHET's Primary health care services are community-oriented, meaning they focus on the needs of the community they serve. This helps to address the unique health needs of each community, including cultural and social factors that may impact health.
