





Rabindranath Tagore was born in Kolkata (formerly known as Calcutta), which became part of post-independence India. Tagore was an accomplished Bengali poet, philosopher, visual artist, playwright, composer and novelist whose works reshaped Bengali literature and music in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. A celebrated cultural icon of Bengal, he became Asia's first Nobel Laureate when he won the 1913 Nobel Prize in Literature. Tagore's major works included Gitanjali (Song Offerings), Gora (Fair-Faced), and Ghare-Baire (The Home and the World). Tagore was also a cultural reformer.
